

PARENT RATING SCALE FOR IDENTIFICATION OF GIFTED CHILDREN

Instructions for filling the scale:

Following is the list of learning characteristics/behaviors demonstrated by potentially gifted children in learning situations. Though many children may demonstrate these behaviors at some point of time during learning, but potentially gifted children will exhibit these traits more frequently and more strongly. Please consider each behavior in the list and rate the learning behavior of the child in different learning contexts.

Mention the rating as:

- 4: The behavior was observed ALWAYS**
- 3: The behavior was observed MOST OF THE TIME**
- 2: The behavior was observed SOMETIMES**
- 1: The behavior was observed RARELY**
- 0: The behavior was NEVER observed**

Instructions to fill the scale:

The scale consists of fifteen traits (behaviors) which a child may demonstrate during learning.

- You must read each trait (behavior) carefully.
- Responses should be based on the observation of behavior of child in multiple situations.
- You shall deliberately create challenging learning situations to see the response and enthusiasm in child.
- Before the final rating, you should observe the nominee in multiple occasions
- You shall rate the child without any prejudice and biases.
